SPRING TRAIL RIDE

Trail bosses, **Barbara Carroll** and **Alan Bagamery** 'headed and heeled' the group consisting of **Debbie Jones** and husband **Rick**, **Jennifer Zimmerman**, and **Patty Meiers** and friend.



The Spring Trail Ride for Legacy, on Saturday, May 17, began as a chilly, cloudy, and windy day. Lake Benbrook park had few visitors as the horse trailers began to arrive and the various mounts unloaded. Although a smaller group than is typical for our trail rides, there was an interesting grouping of horses and riders. Two spots, two grays, two bays and a sorrel (the beginnings of a drill team? A parade line-up?) represented three purebred Arabians, two half-Arabians, a Paint, and a Mustang!

Although the area was suffering from a lack of rain at that time, the trail ride began with a creek crossing that tested the patience of some of the riders. However, this is one advantage of a smaller group, allowing the ones whose horses that had never crossed water before to take the time needed to successfully cross this first obstacle (and it counts even if it takes backing through the obstacle!). Once across, the riders enjoyed getting to know each other and their respective horses as they followed the gentle hills and open pasture-like trails of the first half of Lake Benbrook's almost eight miles of equestrian trails. The group chose the longer meandering scenic loops which afforded an additional water crossing and two mud crossings. These were again challenging for the first time horses but with increasing confidence, each successive task became easier. The riders enjoyed seeing an abundance of wild flowers with a sprinkling of fading bluebonnets and clusters of cactus on the verge of blooming as they rode the first half of the trail. As the morning progresses, the clouds broke, the sun appeared and the temperature warmed to a very comfortable level. The day could not have been any better!

The riders tackled the final leg of the trail, winding up and down the steep hills, through the trees and ended on a high grassy knoll overlooking the lake. A moment in time that these seven riders shared with nature and each other that combined some of the joy and kindred spirit and fun of trail riding. Those of you that have ventured out like this with your horses, know the feeling; those who haven't tried it yet, need to join us on our fall ride and share the moment!

After a long break at this high point of the ride, the group began the trek back to the trailhead anticipating the waiting picnic lunch at the trailers. As the riders returned, they suddenly realized that the cactus blooms had opened! Do they do this each day? Or does this happen only once each Spring? No one knew the answer, but enjoyed the surprise either way. Hope to see you at our next ride!

Be it Resolved that: The terms International Arabian Horse Association or IAHA be changed to Arabian Horse Association or AHA where appearing in the LAHC By-Laws.

Impact: This change has no impact on the Club By-Laws other than to affirm our affiliation with the new Arabian Horse Association, AHA, organization.
