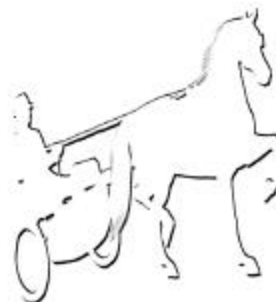
Finally, I want to remind everyone about the Fall Fun Show that we need to plan and execute. Mark your

For everyone unable to attend the June 05 Board meeting, Kathy Braden presented the final numbers from the 2002 Cowtown Classic. After accounting for all expenses, the Club yielded total revenues of \$4,067.88. Specifically, total cash inflows were \$94,873.96 (plus miscellaneous prior year inflows) while total cash outflows were \$91,848.58.
