**General Show Rules:**

- *Attire:* Show attire is not required, but riders must be neat and clean. Boots or riding shoes must be worn in all performance classes. No shorts allowed. **Safety riding helmets are recommended for all performance classes.**
- *Tack:* All training tack and aids are allowed. Schooling equipment is allowed, i.e. snaffle bits, martingales, draw reins, cavassons, permitted in all classes. Inhumane devices will not be allowed on show grounds.
- *Coggins:* Proof of negative Coggins is required for all horses. Certificate must have been issued within the last twelve months for all horses residing in Texas. For horses transported into Texas from other states, certificate must have been issued within the last six months.
- *Placing:* First thru sixth place will be pinned in each class; special awards for high points. Day-end high point will be calculated for both English and Western, JR and SR rider. Series-end highpoint for both disciplines and age groups, and a series-end high point for trail (must attend 3 out of 4 shows) will be awarded.
- *Junior Riders:* Parental approval is required for all exhibitors 17 and under. Release signature for all participants is on the entry form.
- *Fees:* A non-member fee of \$5.00 will be assessed to all non Legacy club members showing in the fun show. High point entry fee will be \$5 per horse per show. Sign up for day-end and year-end high point at desk upon entering.
- *Multiple Horse Discount Fee:* One rider, multiple horses - \$30 ride all day plus \$10 arena fee for first horse; \$20 ride all day plus \$10 arena fee for second horse
- *Parking:* Park in area adjacent to arena. Follow the signs.

## **Class Rules:**

- *Halter:*
  - Halter Showmanship will be posted.
  - Halter color class includes Pintos, Paints, Palominos, and Appaloosas.
  
- *English Classes:*
  - All English tack acceptable.
  - Riders in the walk/trot classes may also enter the classes considered for high-point.
  
- *Western Classes:*
  - All Western tack acceptable.
  - Riders in the walk/trot classes may also enter the classes considered for high-point.
  
- *Lead Line:*
  - Riders must be 7 years old or younger.
  - All riders will be led on the horse by an adult.
  
- *Equitation/Horsemanship Classes:*
  - Classes will be judged on rider form.
  - A pattern, specified by the judge, may be required.
  
- *Glass of Water:*
  - Any tack may be used.
  - Riders will be given a glass filled with water upon entering the ring. Judge will call various gaits, rider with the most water at the end of class wins.
  - Only first place is awarded in this class.
