OPEN HORSE SHOW

The second Open Horse Show was held May 21 at Rancho La Rosa. At the show 6 Arabs, 1 half-Arabian and 6 non-Arabs were shown by 2 members eleven non members.

This year high point awards are being given at each show. The winners in May were Lisa Scott on Lilly receiving High Point English and Christy Reynolds on Corral Creek Miss receiving High Point Western.

The next show sponsored by LAHC is July 16. **NOTE:** This is an evening show and registration will begin at 4:00 p.m. with classes starting at 5:00. The judge at this show will be Frank Pace.

Frank has been showing horses for the last 40 years. He started, like everyone else in this part of the country, showing Quarter horses in halter, Western Pleasure and reining. While attending Sam Houston State to receive a BS degree in Equine Science, Frank was on the horse judging team and showing horses.

In the mid-seventies, he and his wife became involved with Arabians in 4-H and dressage. They coached a 4-H horse judging team that twice went to the Arabian Nationals. The second team placed in the top ten and one member was third individually.

DIRECTIONS TO FOUR MOORE RANCH

Directions: Take 20 west to the Hiway 281 Exit (about 35 miles west of Weatherford). The sign says Stephenville. Follow the road South (toward Stephenville) about 20 miles to Morgan Mill. You will need to slow to 45MPH. There is one cross street in Morgan Mill .FM 1188 . Turn left on 1188 toward Bluff Dale only 1/2 block , in front of Morgan Mill school driveway turn rt on C.R. 156. Follow this thru the old part of town vere left past the new community center. Go over the bridge. We are then 1/2 mile on the right. Black pipe fence C.r. 156 Go up drive about 1/2 mile vere left to house. We are only about 1 mile from Hiway 281.

Alternate Directions: Take 377 south thru Granbury , Tolar, and Bluff Dale. Right after Bluff Dale city limits get in right turn lane. The sign says FM 1188 to Morgan Mill. Turn right. Go over Railroad crossing. Less than 1/2 mile C.R. 156 takes off to the left. Go down this road about 7..5 to 8 miles. County Rd 153 takes off to rt. County Rd 154 takes off to left. That is the start of our property on the left. Go to Black pipe fence. 1822 C.R. 156 turn left in drive.(If you get to the bridge you have gone too far by 1/2 mile) After entering drive vere left to house. If you miss C.R. 156 follow 1188 to Morgan Mill and turn left on C.R. 156 right in front of the driveway to Morgan Mill school. Then follow as above.

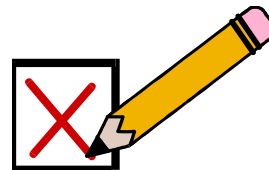
