## PROPOSED LAHC BY LAWS CHANGES

### RESOLUTION # 1 BY LAWS CHANGE – CORRESPONDING SECRETARY

**WHEREAS** the current By Laws prescribe five Officers of the Corporation, one of whom is the **CORRESPONDING SECRETARY**, and

**WHEREAS** the duties of the **CORRESPONDING SECRETARY** have evolved since the By Laws were originally written to the point that, today, no routine corresponding duties need fulfilling, and

**WHEREAS** the desire remains to have the same size Board of Directors as was originally prescribed (11) to facilitate good governance.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the title and duties of the **CORRESPONDENCE SECRETARY**, in Articles V and VI, be deleted and the eleventh member of the Board of Directors be named a **DIRECTOR**, making the total number of **DIRECTORS**, where appearing, six instead of the current five.

And **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** Article V, section 1 of the current By Laws which currently reads

Upon adoption of these bylaws, two members of the Board of Directors shall be elected for a term of two years, and in the succeeding year, three members shall be elected for a two year period. Thereafter, in odd numbered years, two Directors, and in even numbered years, three Directors shall be elected so that all Directors serve a two year term, adding new (or reelected) Directors each year in the annual election.

#### BE AMENDED TO READ

Three Directors shall be elected each year so that all Directors serve a two year term, adding three new or reelected Directors each year in the annual election

### RESOLUTION # 2 BY LAWS CHANGE – NUMBER OF CONSECUTIVE OFFICER TERMS

**WHEREAS** the current bylaws limit the number of consecutive terms an Officer may serve to two terms (two 1-year terms), and

**WHEREAS** it has become increasingly difficult to recruit additional Club Members to volunteer for Officer positions, and

**WHEREAS** recent election slates have become a routine of reshuffling officer titles.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that Article VI of the bylaws, section 1, last sentence which reads:

Any Officer can be re-elected to the same office as long as it does not exceed two consecutive terms.

#### BE AMENDED TO READ

Any Officer can be re-elected to the same office as long as it does not exceed four consecutive terms.

### RESOLUTION # 3 BY LAWS CHANGE – NOMINATING COMMITTEE

**WHEREAS** the current By Laws do not contain requirements for maintaining a Nominating Committee, and

**WHEREAS** the Club Meeting Agenda and Schedule can become difficult without a well pre-planned, functioning Nominating Committee,

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that a permanent Nominating Committee be required by the By Laws, And,

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that Article VI of the By Laws be amended to add the following requirement after all existing words in Article VI, to wit:

**The Past President** shall serve on the Nominating Committee along with any additional members appointed by the President.
